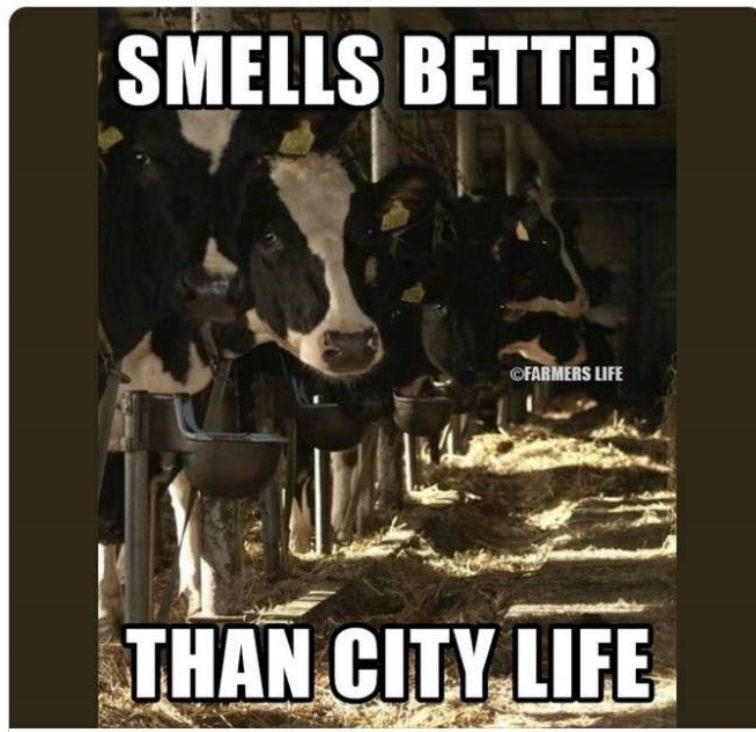

A Memory from my Teens. This was life in the 1950's..Many of us that did have cars were mostly the vintage ones (absent from todays technology.) Just thought I would share some features from my first car, picture taken in 1951. A 1938 Ford It had mechanical brakes (long cables running underneath the car to the individual brake pads, .It had a small 65 horsepower V8, standard shift...automatic transmissions didn't come along in most vehicles until the 1951 models. Inside heat was from a "Manifold heater" [you could buy and install a gas heater on the interior firewall though], no defrosters. You needed to have a small fan mounted on the dash to direct the cabin heat onto the windshield. Windshield wipers were run by a vacuum air line and had very little control over their speed or effectiveness...no windshield washers either, get out of your car and rub snow over the windshield...ah, the good old daysIf you wanted to have side door mirrors, you had to install them yourself , sealed beam headlights had just come into existence and you had to do an extensive and expensive conversion to replace the bulb operated ones. There were NO directional lights so you used hand signals with the window down...even in the winter. Hand signals were part of the drivers road test to obtain your license....Engine starters were also on the floorboards along with high and low beam button and usually started the car...(except on rainy days when wires were wet and wouldn't start). You had to have some mechanical ability to adjust the timing and carburetor settings, install those tire chains for driving in the snow etc etc etc ...we've come a long way baby, but, you know what?? I'D GO BACK IN A HEARTBEAT !! LONG LIVE THOSE FABULOUS 50'S

Gordon Ramsay, a longtime spokesperson for Tyson, has ended his arrangement with them because of it:

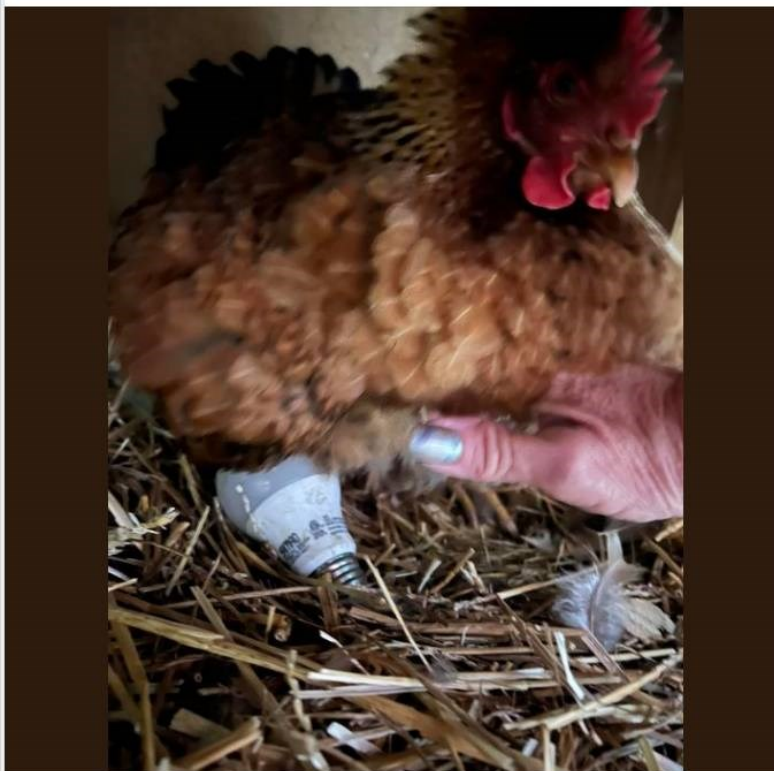
