## **Speed Cameras Installed**

Drivers can expect to see the installation of speed camera equipment in designated school zones over the coming days. Work will occur during daytime hours and will involve signage, radar devices, and camera hardware along roadways near several schools.



The program is expected to go live with the start of the 2025–2026 Williamsburg–James City County school year, which begins on Aug. 25, 2025. A 30-day warning period will follow the activation of the program; during this period, drivers who violate speed limits in designated zones will receive warning notices by mail instead of citations. # Do You Have an Emergency Plan for Your Pets?

Not all shelters and hotels accept pets. Plan ahead to stay with family, friends, or at other pet-friendly locations in case you need to evacuate your home.



#### Pet-Friendly Checklist

- o ID tags on collars and microchip pets
- Have sufficient food, water, and medicine for at least 3 days
- o Pet medication and medication schedule for caregiver, shelter, or boarding staff

- Description and current photos of your pets, including a photo of you and your pet together
- o Immunization and medical records
- o Serving bowls and feeding schedule
- o Collar, leash, and carrier to transport pets safely
- Pet toys and bedding
