ART GARRISON: They talk about one or the other techniques that they're really going to try to do as far as guns is to create liability for those who sell the guns, even if it's not directly related for itself. So, there'll be a very novel, legal strategy. But he's, uh, you know, our first one doing each other, and on the legal side, and... Thank you. Two years ago, three years ago, I had the opportunity to sit down with Trevor and met him when he was... Sadly, in the sight of an incredible effort, I was able to turn around and see... you about. So, nice to meet you. It was remarkable, and it reminded me of, um, how everyday life, there's so much going on, you know, all these things going on in our lives, but in every state, whatever, many grandkids, children... Sorry. 'Cause I'm gonna take home containers. Yeah, absolutely. And then what? The red perfect. In 2009, I had the opportunity to get a reminder from Marco Rubio, our now Secretary of State, who was just running for office, and he, in fact, he was the speaker of the Florida House, and he was working... Nowhere here. He stood up in front of the state like a place in Florida, and he said, God is real. God is real. He said, Jesus Christ came down to save us. And we need that reminder, because if all the everyday things and chaos going on. And when we kind of lose sight of that, whether you're going to church or not, whatever your beliefs are, this country was founded on the morality, the social structure of the Bible and that practice. And no matter how, what other cultures... a little bit about it. These guys... Trevor and Josiah... Oh, my God, Thank you for coming today. I really appreciate it. Thank you. Thanks very much, Art.

TREVOR TOPPING I'm gonna try to keep this as brief as I can, gentlemen, but I cannot. Fantastic. I'm 33 years old. I ran for the board of supervisors when I knew very limited in the county, specific stuff, compared to a lot of you gentlemen, but I was going to rely on a great team of a couple gentlemen in here to, again, bring this Christian conservative value to James City County, which ultimately, money might stay at, but he doesn't. So, I, I, again, I just did on another topic. People my age have asked a lot of questions since 2020 and COVID. and we, our young men and women have seen a lot. And our young men have been turned off, unfortunately, by the Republican Party because we have not hit on some of the right things. And we just missed it with our messaging, and we just missed it again with our messaging and the last election and just took Tim Anderson to work his rear end off out with a lot of other delegates, Chad Green, you name it, AC Cordoza. I mean, it was just a complete blue wave. So, after Charlie, yeah, I reached out to Josiah because there was nothing going on in the peninsula for Charlie Kirkmore. I found out Chuck was actually working on a little something, and we decided to put all of our, you know, heads together to do a Charlie Kirk memorial The co-founder of Inflection Point, Virginia, and I, he, Michael Serber, he's an attorney. So breaking due to his laws over in Walter. We both agreed that Charlie's assassination wasn't in question in point in our name. This election in Virginia is an inflection point in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Josiah has started group called RISE. I'm gonna let him speak on that. But what my mission is, and in question what Virginia's mission is, is to unite the more mature, age, gentlemen, and ladies, in the Commonwealth, with the

younger generation, that, again, didn't show up to vote, because they think politics don't matter, because they see, again, Donald Trump kind of promised, I mean, again, I've been a huge Donald Trump sport. But we haven't seen the... We haven't seen... I don't know... America.... The show... The tacos. Again, with a foreign nation that, again, has been told as our ally, and we're seeing a lot of, again, our tax dollars, our young men going potentially fighting, there's wars, and my generation... has a lot of questions. Frank Sinatra is my favorite actor. I mean, my favorite singer. I love Earth, Wind and Fire. I had that old soul. I am doing this because I'm not sure if I want it on for a, you know, political position again. But I wanted to be involved in saving Virginia. I don't want to run. I don't want to go to Tennessee or Florida. I want to stay right here in the Commonwealth and hold the dad online. I want to hold mine in our country, too, but it starts right here in Hampton Road, and it starts right here in Virginia. So again, in Question Point, Virginia, is brand new. Our goal was to raise money to and meet conservative Christians, encourage them to run for border superbox. School board, delegate and help fundraise them. Josiah, we realized a lot of people that came out to Charlie's event guys. They don't the whole politics thing doesn't really have how much. But they're interested in starting a relationship with Jesus Christ, or they want to unite with more people technology. And that is where, I think, if we help sponsor events that, in our, our rise, in our electric side, speak on that, better geared towards just leading people to sin and worship, and kind of start to feel some of that Holy Spirit, that maybe they didn't feel with the pastor, that they went to church, but then they got turned away. Because Charlie's, at Fascination, also uncovered, again, a lot of good questions, and a lot of big questions about how our big churches nationwide are run and what their true mission is. And again, I think there's a disconnect between the 16 older crowd and the 35 and younger crowd, and they've just seen so much. I've seen so much. We have a lot of questions. My relationship skills, I hope to unite. Again, donor, people who, in this room, have worked and earned a lot more money than I have in my career, right? I understand you're incredibly accomplished, gentlemen, a lot of well intentioned gentlemen. And, you know, we might have a different UR vaccine. We might have a few different views on Israel, but if we go to it, we can continue to describe it, then we can start that relationship there and build a foundation of a following of people who want Christian, value, conservative, Christian value, candidates to be on the school board, to be on the board of supervisors, and to run for delegate. That's how we save your grandchildren's future. My son's future. And so that, if you, I am, one in question point, Virginia, it's mission is inflection point ba.com, I sent the link to carry. You can go right on and again, if you feel in your heart prey on it, we partner with us. We have goals to again get speakers at events, um, that, you know, again, can really bring a positive Christian type message, um, which if people do again, are feeling isolated, feeling lost, and really aren't feeling unity with either political part. And that again is our mission. And Charlie asked a lot of questions. He was asking a lot of questions towards the end of his life. And, uh, you know, at least really uncomfortable conversations, but I enjoy that. I enjoy trying to find truth and ultimately uniting all these people in their small, their small groups and then their churches into one. So we know the best contractor, the best remodeler, the best special medicine doctor, the best investment

advisor, best insurance advisor, and the best farmer to get clean food, and clean energy, and have the most, you know, solid foundation of a house that you're just saying. And that, that is, that is our why. And we're really excited about what the Lord's meeting us do. It also already been part of me, which is tied up. And it's probably the 1st memorial. And so again, I'm going to let Josiah introduce himself. He has started a group called Rise. And, uh, they already have over 450 members on their Facebook group and just start. Our group has far less, again, the people want job. They don't really want out. But if we can lead them to God, and lead them to show that that creed that we just read, and the Republican Party does stand on Christian Bath. That is how we get them engaged and want to go out and go, want to be involved, want to volunteer. And it starts with this man mission rights here. I'm gonna be briefing as well, guys. I didn't know I was speaking, but, um, just heroin me a couple minutes here. Um, you know, right cards to Charlotte, her visual, I met with someone, intent in this image of this. How he, the revolution, was he? We met in taverns, we met in restaurants, and we met in churches. And I love that conversation. We need to do better. Like, we just need to be better. And that thing was just wrong out so true with me. Just in writing everything that we see and everything that's going on, I think we can probably call a agreement. We absolutely need to do better. Um, and so, uh, you know, when Charlotte passed, I'll tell you what, that just worked to me so, so, so, and I, you know, I don't know how she got his life, it's human. I'm telling you, this thing just rows up in the main of like, this boldness and courage and faith out of hand. I was like, this is, I just got to stop wasting time, you know, doing what I'm doing, like, there's so much more, like, the kingdom of God. really arrested my heart, to be honest, and I just... It happened, and I was just, you know, in light of it all, I was just like, man, God, I just want to partner with you right now, because I feel what you want to do, awesome, and amazing things, specifically here in Williamsburg, and Virginia, and, you know, I'm in my truck driving around, and I'm just listening to, like, password life... Please, the speaker. in America. Gene is... Sorry, my speech is my conscious, circumspiritual, because that's where I'm at right now. These are solid. Oh, but I just... the revivals... I'm ready to... I think... No one was in the courthouse. God had just got that nation, or our knees, and they were crying after God. And I just feel like that's where I personally am at guys. And, um, you know, we met for Shirley, Charlie, and people there were just, and it was just so much energy, so much passion, so much of, like, this Jesus being glorified, you were at your courthouse. And it was just such a beautiful thing, such a, such an opposite spirit of, like, that, no king's protest. And everyone there was just like, we need to do this more often. And, you know, and we were like, man, we really do. Like, we need to bring the church together. We need to bring concerns, you know, we hurt nature, people that just love their country, and we need to come together because we're so much stronger together than we are at heart. And, you know, I know, I mean, I look at the Democrats, and I'm like, man, goosehouse are... Yeah, a mission kind of vision, you know, you know, they're going after them. how much more should we be doing? what we need to be doing. So, I don't have everything figured out, but I know that we are watching something called Rise here in Williamsburg, and we are making a call to Williamsburg, to Virginia. We want to take a moment to just gather, and sing Christmas, perils, and ultimately remember why Christmas is important, or the perfect Jesus Christ, we're members in our community. So again, it's, um, we have a Facebook page in Flection Point, Virginia. on our website as well. I mean, I would love to see as many of you there and I'd love to see you bring your family, bring your nephews, bring your grandchildren, and let's all gather. I mean, I pray or have a reception at 7:45. And again, I hope you meet a new friend. I hope you maybe meet someone, you know, just, like, you didn't know in the community, and, uh, you know, I think, again, that revival and that, that holy spirit, we can really, you know, grab that and run with it. That's how we start to build that block by box, our state that we're going to be, you know, again, Charlie said, shine the light of darkest area. Well, those darkest areas are coming right here with JJ, the company in Virginia. And so again, December 12th, 630, we're hurting to get there a little bit early, but then it might be packed. at Oakchart. And, uh, I hope to see you got there. Thank y'all again for lunch, sweet. Jeff put us out in the food, so we'll have to make a couple more... I don't think so. But what I would like to share with you guys, is we have finally triple schedule for the next one, and I'm gonna... Why do we need to contact him to his office? totally sure, you know, what happened between now and then, and that you may not be involved, or...
