

Stop the 10-1 Power Grab

Democrats are pushing a constitutional amendment to redraw Virginia's congressional map to create a 10-1 Democratic advantage, flipping up to four Republican seats and locking in the changes through 2030.

Parts of JCC (Stonehouse A and C) would be in the proposed 8th CD, which runs up to Alexandria and down to York County. A majority of JCC and the entire City of Williamsburg would be in the proposed 4th CD, which extends west to Danville and includes parts of Richmond and its suburbs. Both are blue as can be.

This is a low-turnout special election. That means every Republican vote matters, but only if voters show up and vote NO.
